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Description

AmAs project is supported by MOVETIA Foundation as one of the 18 pilot projects of the carte blanche action for the development of higher education, international mobility and cooperation, with the aim of “expanding the geographic scope of cooperation, while seeking exchange and promoting educational and scientific innovation”.

Specifically, AmAs aims at launching a new combined program between Swiss and Brazil, fostering new listening attitude among in-service teachers – in a multidisciplinary perspective – developing innovative distance learning methodologies based on a customization and adaptation of technologies to different contexts.

The outcome of the educational project consists in a digital open data sonic mapping of selected territories and Podcast production that follows all the activities. The innovative methodologies experimentation – adaptive course and digital sonic mapping – could be evaluated in Swiss formative context, representing an opportunity for all the national educational system.
